Just in time for the new school year, the Welland Safe Community Partnership (WSCP) has announced that its community website has been officially launched.

The website, which can be found at welland.safecommunities.ca, provides up- to-date information on the programs and accomplishments of the WSCP, as well as several links to other safety-related resources.

"There have been several exciting undertakings within the past year, including the National Report Card, the development of business and volunteer safety ambassador awards and new designation criteria," said Bill Auchterlonie WSCP chair.
